Volunteers are needed to provide a timely, effective, free and impartial advice and assistance on a one-off or short-term basis, to disabled or older people to resolve their computer related issues in their home and/or remotely.

Veterans Community Support Volunteer

Across Moray

Volunteers are essential to Legion Scotland's ability to support veterans in the community. We are currently recruiting volunteers to enable us to deliver the new 'Veterans Community Support Service'.

Trained and supported volunteers will be 'matched' with Armed Forces veterans and then provide a befriending relationship in the community – this could take the form of a regular social visit to relieve isolation and loneliness, or else to provide assistance with more specific issues at other times – training and support are provided and volunteers will be PVG checked prior to contact with clients. This is not a personal care or advisory service.

Community based – volunteers could meet clients in their homes (risk assessments and lone working policies are carried out as part of our service); or meet at café's or other public places. A volunteer might also support a client to attend a regular group or event.

Natural Build Learning & Volunteering Opportunities

Aberlour, Speyside

A practical hands on experience of how to build a straw bale house from foundations to finishes. Volunteers helping on the project can learn about: Roundwood framing, stone foundations, green roofs, straw bale installation, clay plaster, lime plaster and earth floors.

Educational discussions on each stage of the build will cover: materials science, design details, natural materials & everything else that comes up. This has been factored into the build time. It is our upmost commitment to educate volunteers in return for their hard work. Meals will be provided.

The build is happening in Aberlour, Speyside and volunteers would need access to transport. Camping space and facilities will be available for interns. Volunteers will need own transport to Aberlour. Lifts can be available from Aberlour to site.

Group Facilitator/Group Support Volunteer

Driver/escort roles are also available and all costs to the volunteer are reimbursed.
